**RESOLUTION OF THE UKIAH VALLEY SANITATION DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS
ADOPTING THE COUNTY OF MENDOCINO POLICY NO. 31 RELATED TO REPRODUCTION
AND COPYING CHARGES**

WHEREAS, the administration of Ukiah Valley Sanitation District Board of Directors is conducted through the County of Mendocino; and

WHEREAS, the Ukiah Valley Sanitation District is an independent Special District with a Board Member from the Ukiah City Council and two Board Members from the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Ukiah Valley Sanitation District Board of Directors' agenda packets and minutes, as well as other District documents are available for public inspection and reproduction through County of Mendocino Departments; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Ukiah Valley Sanitation District Board of Directors to adopt the County of Mendocino's reproduction and copying policy (Policy No. 31) in order to formally establish copying and reproduction fees for interested member of the public requesting copies of District documents.

RESOLVES AND SO ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

The County of Mendocino Policy No. 31 titled Standard Copying Fees is adopted and approved, including any future amendment to said policy by the County of Mendocino Board of Supervisors, as the Ukiah Valley Sanitation District's official copying fee policy for all District documents copied or reproduced by the County of Mendocino.


