RESOLUTION OF THE UKIAH VALLEY SANITATION DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS ABANDONING A SEWER EASEMENT GRANTED TO THE DISTRICT AND LOCATED WITHIN CITY OF UKIAH PROPERTY RECORDED IN INSTRUMENT NO. 2008-07873 AND DESIGNATED AS THE ORCHARD SUBSTATION PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE BOARD CHAIR TO EXECUTE THE QUITCLAIM DEED

WHEREAS, the Ukiah Valley Sanitation District Board of Directors (District Board) may sell, lease, or otherwise dispose of any property of the District or any interest therein whenever it is no longer required for the purposes of the District, or when its use may be permitted without interfering with its use by the District pursuant to the provisions of Section 4743 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California and the District Board has adopted Policy Number 3050 concerning the abandonment of easements, and

WHEREAS, the City of Ukiah has acquired land at the southwest corner of Gobbi Street and Orchard Ave recorded as Instrument No. 2008-07873 for the purpose of constructing a new electrical substation and the City has cleared the site for said use which required the demolition of two residential structures that were once served by a district sewer lying within a 16 foot wide strip of land commonly known as Robinson Lane, and

WHEREAS, Mary Robinson granted a sewer easement over the 16 foot wide Robinson Lane to the Ukiah Valley Sanitation District in the grant deed recorded July 2, 1955 in Book 515, Page 546 of Official Records of Mendocino, and

WHEREAS, the District sewer lying within the 16 foot wide easement is no longer needed to serve the property and the City has disconnected and abandoned in place the sewer line and the easement is not needed to serve adjacent properties in the future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the District Board orders the abandonment of that portion of the sewer easement granted to the District by Mary Robinson by the grant deed recorded on July 2, 1955 in Book 515, Page 546 of Official Records of Mendocino County that lies within the City of Ukiah property recorded in Instrument No. 2008-07873, Mendocino Records. Said abandoned easement is described and shown in Exhibits "A" and "B" as attached. The Board Chair is hereby authorized to execute the Easement Quitclaim Deed

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
